


3. How do you know what science your child does in school?


4. Would you be interested in doing some science experiments with your child at home from time to time?


5. Is any member of your family working in one of the STEM fields?


6. If family member in a STEM fields, would they be interested in in presenting to the junior school children in person or by Zoom?




8. What area of STEM do you think is most importance?


9. How would you describe your daughter's attitude to STEM?
